**Tenancy Assistance and Advocacy Program (TAAP) – Inner East**

Tenancy Assistance and Advocacy Program (TAAP) helps Victorians who have a private residential tenancy agreement who are experiencing financial disadvantage or family violence (regardless of financial circumstances). This includes helping those in private rental, privately operated rooming houses and caravan parks. TAAP assists these tenants to resolve their possible tenancy issues, maintain tenancies and achieve positive outcomes.

**Family Reconciliation and Mediation Program (FRMP).**

FRMP is a state-wide program to assist young people aged 16–25 years that are experiencing or at risk of homelessness.
