

Youth Homelessness Support Services.

We deliver youth support programs for young people aged 15-25 in the Eastern Metro Region who are experiencing or are at risk of homelessness and family breakdown. To access support, young people can contact us or drop into our Ringwood entry point, with youth workers available to triage calls and presentations.

Youth Homelessness Support

This program provides case management to young singles and families living in Transitional Housing as well as outreach support. We work with young people to address barriers that may be contributing to their homelessness and support them to access safe, sustainable, and affordable long-term housing. The program provides information, resources, and practical assistance to empower young people toward independence.

Young people experiencing immediate housing crisis can present to our Ringwood office for a youth specific homelessness response and referrals.

Front Door Family Reconciliation

The Family Reconciliation program assists young people to strengthen relationships and improve connections with family. The program seeks to engage with family members to resolve identified issues while maintaining the young person's engagement with education, relationships with family and friends, accommodation, and links with the community.

Creating Connections

Creating Connections provides support to young people to develop live and living skills such as cooking, cleaning, money management, household management and interpersonal skills. Creating Connections also works with young people to create and maintain pathways to education, employment and training options. Brokerage is available to support young people to achieve their education employment and training goals.
