1. Who Do Youth Ambassador's represent?

- Youth Ambassador are passionate emerging young leaders who are passionate to see young people in care get opportunities to reach their potential.
- o Youth Ambassadors help represent and be a voice for the children and young people in the Outer East who have a lived experience of care and transitioning from care.
- o Youth Ambassadors help guide Brighter futures in a number of ways
- o Youth Ambassadors have a range of experiences and interests and identify with a diverse range of community groups.

2. What's The Time Commitment Like?

- o As a Youth Ambassador your happy to attend and contribute to monthly face to face meetings with your Youth Advisory Group (YAG)
- o You're happy to participate in regular communications through email, smart ph app and teleconferences.
- o We encourage Youth Ambassadors to contribute to focus groups on specific topics of interest held throughout the year.

3. Are Youth Ambassadors Paid?

- o Yes!
- o Brighter Futures value what young people contribute and bring with them to help guide us!
- o Youth Ambassadors are paid at a rate of \$50 per half day or with gift cards of equivalent value (if happy to receive them)
- o Examples include Youth Ambassadors being paid to attend and contribute to face meetings, events, invites they attend, help plan etc
- We will negotiate with you to help cover reasonable travel costs.

4. What Opportunities Do Youth Ambassador's Get?

- o Tons!
